

Thanks to EKOenergy consumers, we have been able to finance 79 renewable energy projects, in 29 countries.

All projects contribute to multiple SDGs, such as "No poverty" "Zero hunger" and "Good health and well-being".



10 YEARS OF... fighting energy poverty

- For each MWh of EKOenergy, 0.10€ goes to our Climate Fund. With these contributions, we finance renewable energy projects in developing countries.
- All projects focus on fighting energy poverty and are implemented in cooperation with local NGOs and communities.
- The projects are selected with the help of an independent jury.

14 projects took place in Mali and 11 in Nepal.

Most projects bring solar power to off-grid villages, hospitals and schools.

Most grants are between 15,000€ and 35,000€. In 2020 we granted 313,000€ to a 4-year solar project in Kenya.

So far we have granted a total of 2,287,798 €.

Since 2015 we have organised an annual call for projects. Each year we get hundreds of applications.

50 projects took place in Africa, 24 in Asia, and 5 in Latin America.

We evolved from financing 1 project in 2014, to financing 15 in 2022.
